The RAVE Shelter Map

For the first time in history, you can search for information on a transition house or shelter nearest you. Note: North America only.

To begin, follow these simple instructions:


Step 1. At the bottom of the screen, choose a country you would like to search.

Step 2. Choose which Province (Canada) or State (USA) to search in.

Step 3. Scroll over an icon and click to display all available information.

Step 4. NEW* You can now enter a city to refine your search.

Please note: Shelter icons will not appear until the above instructions are complete.

Once you click on a shelter icon , information about that location will appear above it. For most shelters, you then have the option of emailing them directly, or visiting their website by clicking on the blue text.
